Established in 1942. This little gem, like so many others, is run by the stylish widow Chantal and her beautiful daughter Angéline. Their Champagnes are characterized by broad, ripe, exotic fruit. They have few critics and the wines are exceedingly drinkable. The Chardonnay wine is among the very best outside of Côte des Blancs. The grower has had unprecedented success in the U.S.A. A wine that perfectly personifies the domain style is the 2004 Special Club. We have here a very lovely, stylish wine that reminds one of the breadth of the great companies. My thoughts are drawn to Pol Roger with its fine tone of newly-baked bread, its hint of chocolate and nuts and its tersely elegant fruitiness. Anything but a typical growers' Champagne. Already saturated with honey with a fantastic promise of essences.

Medium-depp colour, impeccable mousse, balanced bready nose. The flavour is soft and uncomplicated with aftertaste that is typical of the house.
